Priorities of the Erasmus+ programme



Inclusion and diversity – involve **participants with fewer opportunities** (barriers related to disability and health problems, education and training systems, cultural differences, social, economic, discrimination and geographical barriers); projects with inclusive approach



Digital transformation – promote the use of **digital technologies** in teaching and learning; as well as promoting digital literacy as it has become an essential part of everyday life



Environment and the fight against climate change – build knowledge, skills and attitudes about **climate change and sustainable development**; development of strategies, methodologies and curricula, etc.; environmentally friendly practices in all projects

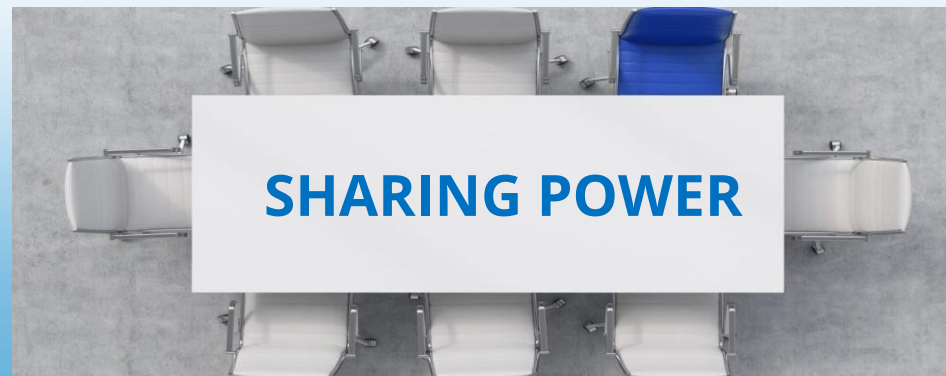


Information and participation in democratic processes – increase **knowledge about the European Union**, support social and civic involvement; promote media literacy

ACTIVE PARTICIPATION

Participation is a process in which **everyone has the opportunity to participate** in deciding on issues that are important to them and shaping their surroundings with the aim of **improving** their own quality of life and that of their fellow human beings.

Active participation is an essential element in the involvement of pupils, students, volunteers, teachers, academic staff, administrative staff, etc. in the implementation of projects!



PARTICIPATION IN DEMOCRATIC LIFE, COMMON VALUES AND CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

Erasmus+ programme priority: to promote participants' involvement in democratic processes and their awareness and understanding of the European Union, especially of the EU's common values.



The programme supports active citizenship and ethics in lifelong learning, it fosters the development of **social and intercultural competences, critical thinking and media literacy**;



Raising awareness of and understanding the European Union context, notably in regards the **common EU values and the principles of unity and diversity, as well as their social, cultural and historical heritage**;



In addition to formal education, non-formal learning can **enhance the citizens' understanding of the European Union and foster a sense of belonging**.

Why is active participation important?



- **Improves project quality and success:**
 - Broader participation in decision-making and planning;
 - Better understanding of goals and needs;
 - Support and sense of responsibility.
- **Promotes mutual understanding, innovation, and collaboration:**
 - Exchange of cultures and perspectives;
 - Idea generation and co-creation process;
 - Long-term cooperation networks.
- **Helps ensure sustainable engagement even after the project ends:**
 - Transfer of experience into everyday practice;
 - Contribution to community development;
 - Use of resources and contacts for future objectives.
