- Enhancing teamwork through digital networks.



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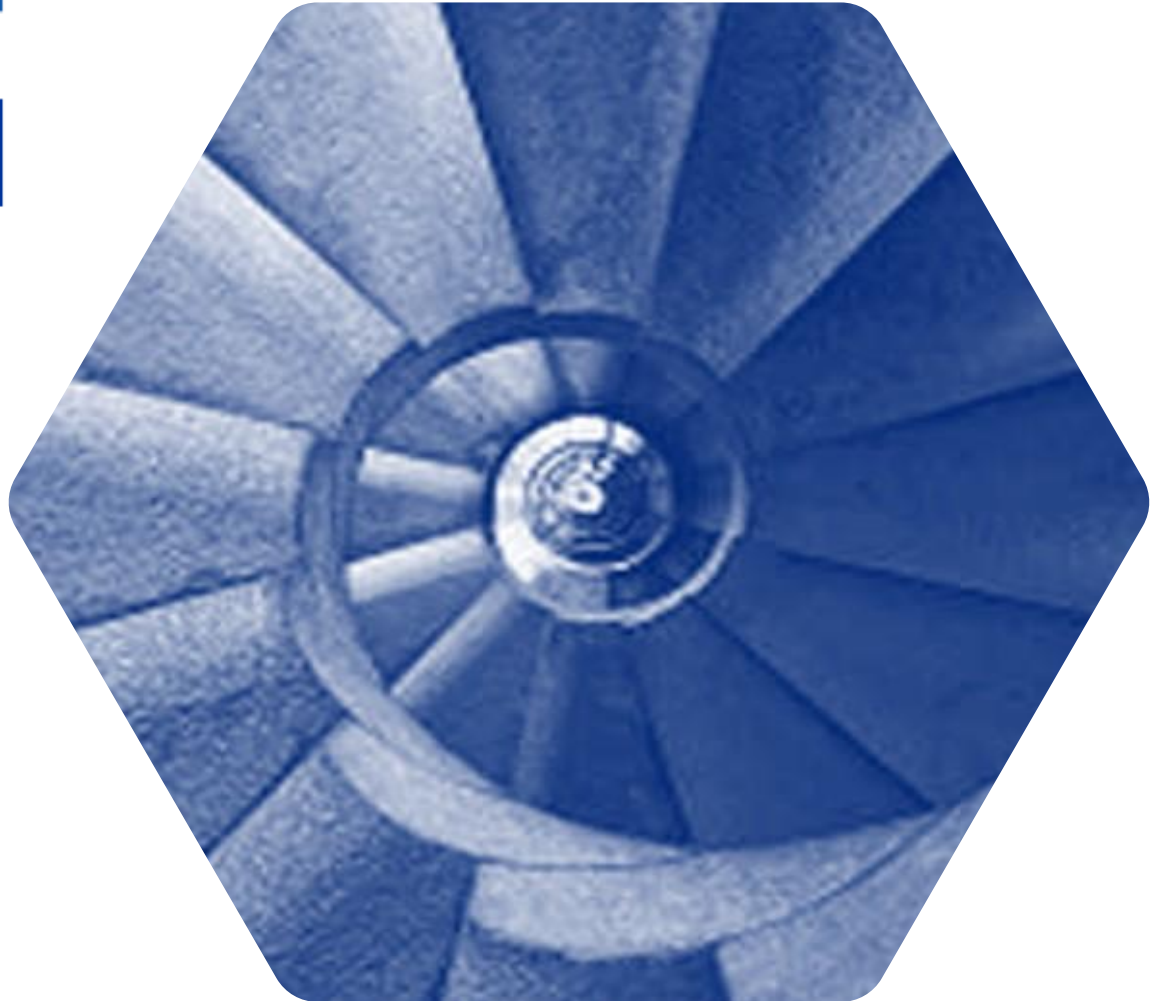


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Project goal

Creating a methodology for assessing, training, and monitoring the digital skills, refining it based on shared experiences



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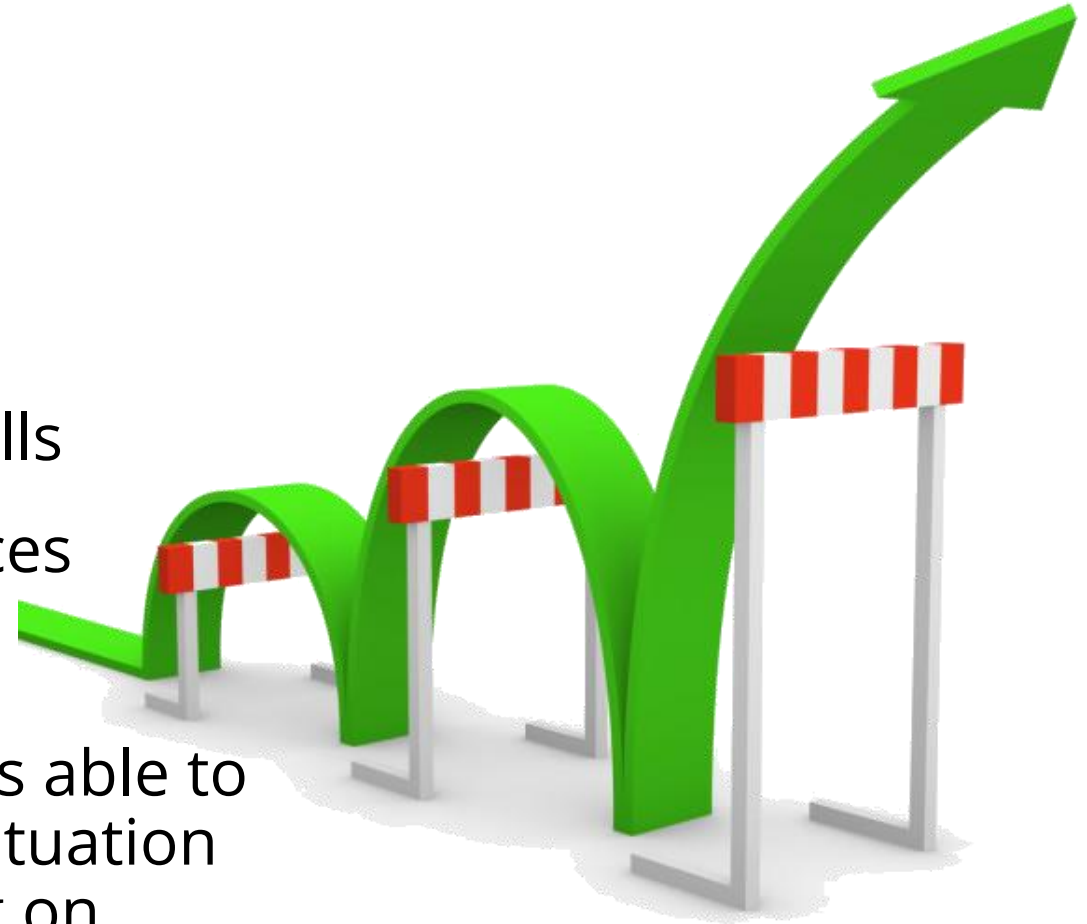
Methodology

Steps

1. Creating self-assessment of digital skills
2. Defining template of the Good Practices
3. Setting common indicators
4. Formulating delivery of policy changes able to close/narrow gaps between current situation and targeted scenarios by capitalising on demonstrated successful experiences.
