- Enhancing teamwork through digital networks.










Project goal

Methodology

Study visits, seminars, and workshops will allow partners to exchange knowledge, innovate practices, and find solutions.









Steps

- 1. Creating self-assessment of digital skills
- 2. Defining template of the Good Practices
- 3. Setting common indicators
- 4. Formulating delivery of policy changes able to close/narrow gaps between current situation and targeted scenarios by capitalising on demonstrated successful experiences.
